Welcome to the Fifth round of the Victorian State Circuit Racing Championships, organised and promoted by the Victorian Mini Club. Your entry has been provisionally accepted and you have been nominated to contest the events for your category. You may be required by the Scrutineers to check with the Secretary of the Meeting to tidy up minor omissions to your entry before being permitted to practice.

Timetable and Drivers Briefing

The timetable is attached, please read it carefully. You will be called to the marshalling area fifteen minutes before your session or event. Drivers not there within five minutes may jeopardise their position on the grid. Drivers Briefing will be in the Muster Shed. Time of Briefings are on the attached schedule

Timing : DATA-1 TRANSMITTERS

Race timing will be conducted by way of DATA-1 Transmitters. All cars will be required to carry a transmitter during practice and racing.

Drivers Wristbands

A coloured wristband will be placed on all Drivers at the time Document Checking is done at the Secretary's Office. You are required to wear the wristband for the duration of the Event. You will be asked to show it to the Officials in the Marshalling Area. If you do not have a wristband you will NOT be permitted on the racetrack. A replacement wristband will only be issued on the return of the original.

Scrutineering

Targeted Scrutiny procedures will apply at this Event. All Drivers must present themselves with their licence (CAMS PCC competition licence or superior) and log book, Club membership card to the Secretary's Office **prior** to presentation of their vehicle for practice. When the paperwork check is satisfactorily completed a "Scrutiny" sticker will be issued, enabling the vehicle to compete.

All Target Scrutiny vehicles must have been audited within the last twelve months or not more than four meetings, which ever is the least. Vehicles not complying may not be permitted to start.

All cars must be presented with their correct race number on both sides of the car and the bonnet or windscreen.

Marshalling Area

The Marshalling Area will be at the **north end of the pit paddock**. From the Marshalling Area Drivers will be directed onto the track. Before leaving the Marshalling Area prior to a race, Drivers will be placed under Starter's orders and shown the one-minute board. They will then proceed onto the track for a warm up lap.

Practice

All Drivers are required to complete at least four laps of practice. A race is scheduled for Saturday afternoon. If any categories wish to have a second practice session instead of a race, the Secretary of the Meeting must be advised prior to midday on Saturday. Any category requiring this change will need to demonstrate class consensus. The first ten minutes of the SPORTS SEDAN practice session will be exclusively for Sports Sedans.

Gridding

Grid positions for the first event in each category will be based on practice times, or where applicable at the discretion of the Chief Timekeeper. Progressive Grid positions based on the finishing order of the previous race will apply for subsequent events. Grid sheets will be posted at the Secretary's office.

Warm Up Lap

Vehicles will enter the track via Marshalling and Pit Lane, continue on past the start line without stopping and complete the warm up lap. Drivers are reminded that the warm up lap must be conducted at a brisk pace. Any category taking excessive time will have a lap deducted from the length of their race. This is necessary if we are to keep to the tight schedule set out in the program.

Race start

All races will be non-championship standing starts. Races for Sports Sedans may be Non Championship Rolling starts, upon agreement with the Clerk of the Course and Category representatives. Drivers will be notified at the Drivers Briefing.

Accidents

Any Driver involved in an accident during practice or racing must be examined by the Chief Medical Officer (Doctor). Drivers will not be permitted to continue competing unless examined and cleared by the Doctor.

Safety Car Procedure

It may be necessary during the course of the meeting to make use of the Safety Car to neutralise a race. Drivers should make themselves familiar with the Safety Car Procedures in the CAMS Manual at chapter 6.12 Race Meeting Standing Regulations.

Variation of Events

It may be necessary to vary the Event Schedule, if this occurs competitors will be informed and a notice displayed at the Secretary's Office. Drivers gridded in events outside their category for any reason will be individually notified.

Judges of Fact

Michael Holloway, Bob Anderson, Keith McKay, Peter Rosier, Jeremy Coakley, Darren McKeemish, (and other Officials if appointed) shall be the Judges of Fact in regard to compliance with starting procedures and relative positions at the completion of each event.

Licence Upgrade and Maintenance signatures

Drivers who may and require a signature by the Clerk of the Course or the Stewards (in the case of an International upgrade) for licence upgrade or maintenance, are requested to lodge their licences at the Secretary's Office on Saturday. We will attempt to sign licences throughout the day and they may be collected (from the Secretary's office) at the conclusion the last race for your category on Sunday.

Circuit Exit

Following the display of the chequered flag, cars should proceed around the circuit then exit at Turn 4 and return to the Pits. Cars retiring during the race for any reason, should use the exit prior to the main straight. The Turn 4 exit is not to be used while a race or practice session is in progress.

Paddock

Each competing vehicle is permitted to have **one** tender vehicle enter the Pits. All other vehicles must be left outside (prior to the tunnel) in the areas provided. The tender pass supplied to each Competitor must be affixed to the vehicles windscreen. After unloading **TENDER VEHICLES & TRAILERS MUST BE REMOVED TO THE TRAILER PARK.** All "No Standing" areas must be kept clear. Competitors not heeding these requirements may be excluded from the Event.

Substitution of nominated Driver

Any proposed substitution of a nominated Driver must be notified to the Clerk of the Course or the Secretary of the Meeting at least one hour prior to the event, and the Entry Form amended accordingly. Only one Diver per entry is permitted.

Recovery

Where possible, vehicles will be removed from the track after each event. If your vehicle stops on the track, retire to a safe place until the conclusion of the event. Return immediately to your vehicle to assist the Recovery Crews. If you are in a vehicle being towed you must have all your safety equipment on, including helmet, until you return to the Paddock.

Garages

Garage Keys may be obtained from the Secretary's office. Keys must be returned to the Secretary's office and garages left in a clean and tidy state.

Fuel

Fuel will be available from Race Fuels Service at the track on both Saturday and Sunday from 8.30 a.m. to 4.30p.m. Either cars or METAL CONTAINERS ONLY will be filled. No plastic containers may be used. Fuel sales will be on a cash basis - no accounts will be operated. Competitors are reminded that fuel must be in accordance with Schedule G of the CAMS Manual.

Litter

We are using the facilities of Phillip Island Grand Prix Circuit, we must leave the facility litter free. Please clean up around you before leaving and use either the bins provided or take your litter with you.

Access to the Track

All Competitor access is via Gate 2 on Back Beach Road at the northwest corner of the property. From this gate Competitors will proceed through the Spectator Area to the tunnel under the track and then direct to the Competitors Paddock. The tunnel has a maximum clearance of four metres and vehicles exceeding this height must make prior arrangements with the property management. Please note that access to the track is not available on Thursday.

Officials

The Officials are all there because they enjoy being involved in motor sport. They all have their specific responsibilities, so please follow their instructions or directions so that everybody can have a safe and enjoyable weekend of motor racing.

At the completion of practice and racing on **SATURDAY & SUNDAY** it is intended to hold a Regularity trial for those Officials who wish to take part. All Drivers in this event must be holders of a CAMS Speed Licence or superior and sign the appropriate indemnity. In order to participate in the regularity trial participants need to have satisfied one of the following criteria: 1/ Previous experience in a regularity trial 2/ Attendance at a CAMS Licence Lecture 3/ Successful completion of an advanced driving course.)

Social

Again this year there will be a social gathering for DRIVERS, CREW and OFFICIALS in the Canteen following the completion of activities on Saturday. The food and drink will be provided **FREE**. We encourage all Driver, Competitors to attend, most of the Officials and helpers will be there.

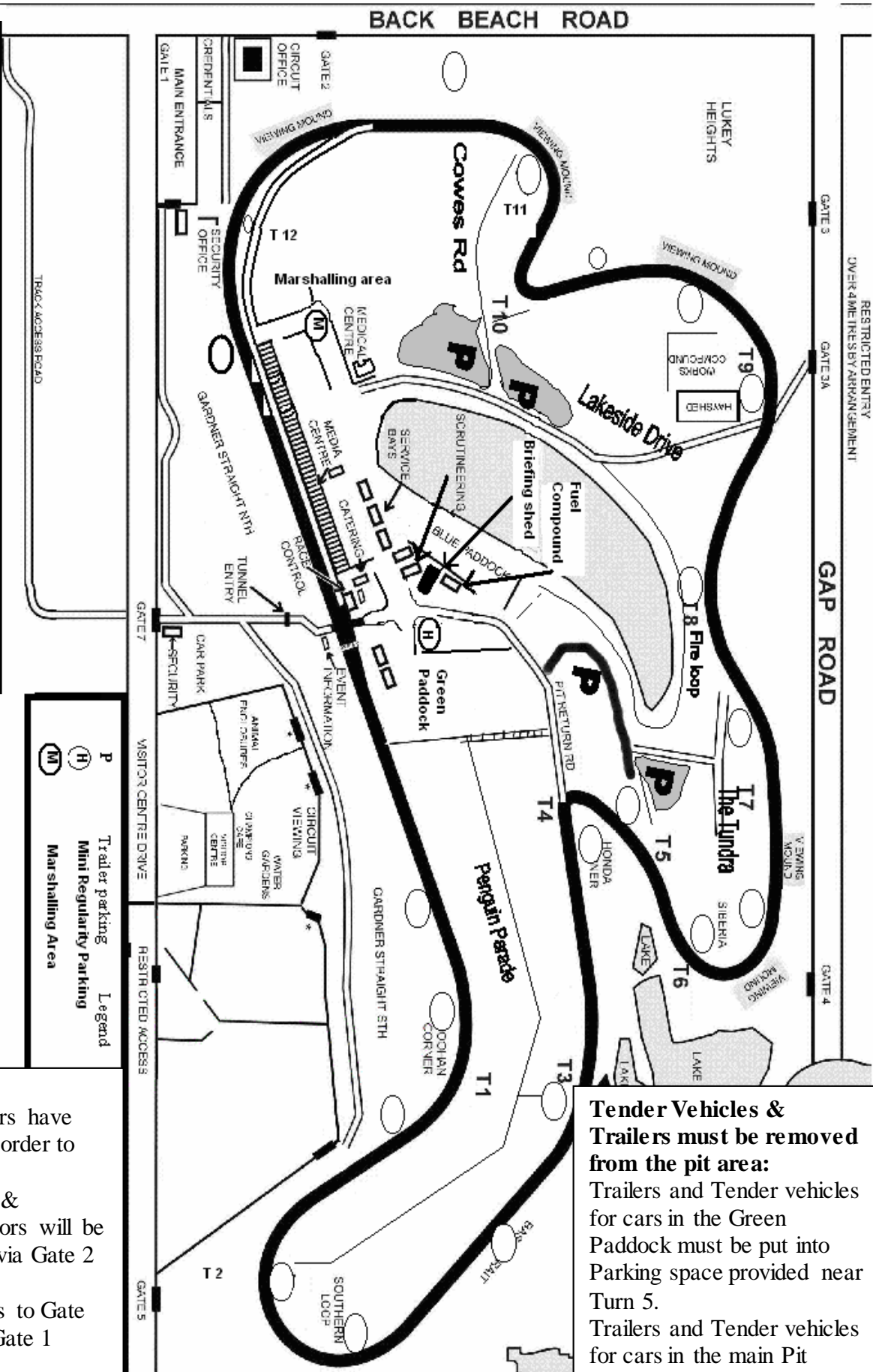
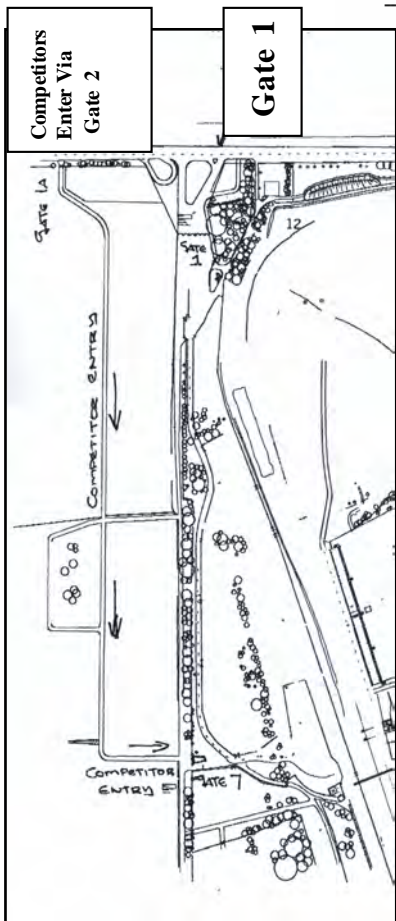

RISK WARNING, DISCLAIMER AND INDEMNITY

Motor Sport Activities are inherently dangerous recreational activities and there is significant risk of injury, disability or death.

If you do not wish to be exposed to such risks, then you should not participate in the Motor Sport Activities.

I **acknowledge** that:

- the risks associated with attending or participating in Motor Sport Activities include but are **NOT LIMITED** to the risk that I may suffer harm as a result of:
 - motor vehicles (or parts of them) colliding with other motor vehicles or persons or property;
 - others participants acting dangerously or with lack of skills;
 - high levels of noise exposure;
 - acts of violence and other harmful acts (whether intentional or inadvertent) committed by persons attending or participating in the event; and
 - the failure or unsuitability of facilities (including grand-stands, fences and guard rails) to ensure my safety.

EXCLUSION OF LIABILITY, RELEASE & INDEMNITY

In exchange for being able to attend or participate in the Motor Sport Activities, I **agree**:

- to **release** CAMS and the Entities to the extent that any or all of them are providing Recreational Services from all liability for:
 - a) my **death**;
 - b) any **physical or mental injury** (including the aggravation, acceleration or recurrence of such an injury);
 - c) the contraction, aggravation or acceleration of a **disease**;
 - d) the coming into existence, the aggravation, acceleration or recurrence of any other **condition, circumstance, occurrence, activity, form of behaviour, course of conduct or state of affairs**:
 - i. that is or may be harmful or disadvantageous to me or the community; or
 - ii. that may result in harm or disadvantage to me or the community,howsoever arising from my participation in or attendance at the Motor Sport Activities;
- to **indemnify and hold harmless and keep indemnified** the Entities to the maximum extent permitted by law in respect of any Claim by any person; and
- to attend at or participate in the Motor Sport Activities **at my own risk**.

I **understand** that:

- nothing in this document excludes, restricts or modifies any rights that I may have as a result of significant personal injury that is caused by the Reckless Conduct of the Entities as the supplier of the Motor Sport Activities / Recreational Services;
- nothing in this document prevents the Entities from relying on any laws (including statute and common law) that limit or preclude their liability;
- nothing in this document excludes any term or guarantee which under statute cannot be excluded; however the liability of the Entities is limited to the minimum liability allowable by law;
- nothing in this document precludes me from making a claim under a CAMS insurance policy where I am expressly entitled to make a claim under that insurance policy; and
- CAMS has arranged some limited personal injury insurance coverage which may provide me with some protection for loss, damage or injury that I may suffer during my participation in the Motor Sport Activities. However, I acknowledge and accept that the insurance taken out by CAMS may not provide me with full indemnity for loss, damage or injury that I may suffer during my participation in the Motor Sport Activities, and that I may have to pay the excess if a Claim is made under an insurance policy on my behalf. I agree that my own insurance arrangements are ultimately my responsibility and I will arrange any additional coverage at my expense after taking into account CAMS insurance arrangements, this document and my own circumstances.

Where Motor Sport Activities are held in the following jurisdictions, I acknowledge that I have also read and accept the following warnings:

WARNING APPLICABLE IN RELATION TO MOTOR SPORT ACTIVITIES HELD IN VICTORIA

WARNING UNDER THE AUSTRALIAN CONSUMER LAW AND FAIR TRADING ACT 2012:

Under the Australian Consumer Law (Victoria), several statutory guarantees apply to the supply of certain goods and services. These guarantees mean that the supplier named on this form is required to ensure that the recreational services it supplies to you:

- are rendered with due care and skill;
- are reasonably fit for any purpose which you either expressly or by implication, make known to the supplier; and
- might reasonably be expected to achieve any result you have made known to the supplier.

Under section 22 of the **Australian Consumer Law and Fair Trading Act 2012 (Vic)**, the supplier is entitled to ask you to agree that these conditions do not apply to you. If you sign this form, you will be agreeing that your rights to sue the supplier under the **Australian Consumer Law and Fair Trading Act 2012** if you are killed or injured because the services were not in accordance with these guarantees, are excluded, restricted or modified in the way set out in this form.

- d. "Motor Sport Activities" means any motor sport activities or Recreational Services which are permitted or approved which CAMS regulates or administers by CAMS or otherwise under the responsibility / control of CAMS;
