



2022 Victorian State Circuit Racing Championships Round 4 SANDOWN INTERNATIONAL MOTOR RACEWAY 12 – 14 August 2022 General Supplementary Regulations

1. AUTHORITY

The Event will be held under the FIA International Sporting Code including Appendices, the National Competition Rules (NCR) and the Circuit Race Standing Regulations of Motorsport Australia, the 2022 Victorian State Circuit Racing Championship Series Regulations, the Sandown Raceway Standing Venue Regulations and these General Supplementary Regulations and any Further Regulations or instructions that may be issued. The Event is to be held in accordance with Motorsport Australia OH&S, Safety 1st, Integrity and Legal, and Risk Management Policies, which can be found on the Motorsport Australia website at www.motorsport.org.au.

5. EVENT DESCRIPTION

The Event will be a State Championship Race Event held over three days (Friday 12 Aug will be a Private Practice activity). The activities will be conducted at Sandown International Motor Raceway and cars will circulate in an anticlockwise direction of the 3.1 km National Circuit.

6. ENTRIES

The preferred method of entry is via Motorsport Australia Event Entry-

www.evententry.motorsport.org.au/UpcomingEvent or by email to galeesmith@hotmail.com. Those using know how easy it is. For all others, we strongly encourage you to use this time saving system. There is a tutorial on the website for first timers and a telephone help number for use during business hours.

Entries will open on publication of the Supplementary Regulations and close on Friday 23 July 2022 except for the Friday practice activity for which entries close 9.00am Friday 12 August 2022. Competitors are reminded of the NCR of the current Motorsport Australia Manual regarding refusal of entries. The Entry Fee will be \$250.00 GST Inc for the Friday practice activity, and for the Saturday/Sunday will be \$495.00 GST Inc. The maximum number of entries accepted for the Event will be 356.

A surcharge of \$110 including GST applies to any entry which nominates for more than one class with the same Driver. In these cases the Driver must indicate on the Entry Form their first and second choice of which category they would like to run. A separate full entry fee is payable if the cross entry is for the same vehicle but with a different Driver. A separate full Entry Fee is also payable if a Driver enters more than one category with a different vehicle.

There are Garages for hire on a first come first served basis. The Garage Form has all the details.

Each Competitor must hold a Motorsport Australia Competition Licence unless they comply with (a) or (b) below. Each Driver must hold a minimum of a Motorsport Australia Circuit Licence with Provisional Endorsement unless noted otherwise against a particular Event or specified otherwise in the Sporting Regulations for the relevant Championship/Cup/Series/Trophy/etc or;

- (a) Hold a Motor Sport New Zealand competition licence and Trans-Tasman Visa valid for the Event; or
- (b) Hold a minimum of the highest grade National Licence issued by a foreign ASN together with an authorisation issued by that ASN for the Event; Such Drivers and Competitors:
 - (i) Shall be ineligible to score points in any Championship/Cup/Series/Trophy/etc connected with the Event; and
 - (ii) must receive an authorisation to compete from Motorsport Australia prior to the Event;

Preferred competition numbers must be requested on the Entry Form. These will be allocated on first come first served basis, or if the categories have their own pre allocated numbers, then they will be used.

7. GENERAL INFORMATION

- (a) Certain public, property, professional indemnity and personal accident insurance is provided by Motorsport Australia in relation to the Event. Further details can be found in the Motorsport Australia Insurance Handbook, available at www.motorsport.org.au.
- (b) Protests, if any, must be lodged in accordance with the NCR.
- (c) The Promoter reserves the right to cancel, postpone or abandon the Event in accordance with the NCR.
- (d) Timing will be electronic and each competitor will require a DATA-1 Transmitter.
- (e) The Organisers reserve the right to refuse an entry in accordance with the NCR.

8. ALCOHOL, DRUGS AND OTHER SUBSTANCES

The holder of a Motorsport Australia Licence (or a Licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of any drug or other banned substance and subject to a penalty for a breach of the Australian National Anti-Doping Policy and/or the Motorsport Australia Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy at www.motorsport.org.au.

Consumption of alcohol in the paddock, pits or any other Reserved Area is prohibited until all Competition is concluded each day. The holder of a Motorsport Australia Licence (or a Licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of alcohol by a Motorsport Australia Accredited Testing Official (CATO) in accordance with the Motorsport Australia Alcohol Policy at www.motorsport.org.au.

9. CATEGORY PARTICIPATION

Qualifying/Racing will be provided for cars complying with the 2022 Motorsport Australia Regulations for the following categories: Formula Ford 1600 & Formula Ford, Improved Production Cars (including BMW E30), Formula Vee, Formula Open, Porsche 944 Challenge Cars, Saloon Cars, Circuit Excels, Sports Cars & Vic V8's complying with VSCRC Series Regulations

10. TARGETED SCRUTINY

Targeted Scrutiny procedures will be applied at this Event. Vehicle logbooks will be checked by Scrutineers to confirm which vehicles are due for audit. Please note that this does not mean your car will not be subject to Scrutiny throughout the weekend. All Driver apparel must comply with Schedule D of the 2022 Motorsport Australia Manual.

11. FINAL REGULATIONS AND PASSES

Final Regulations and other documents will be emailed to you – **ENSURE YOUR CORRECT EMAIL ADDRESS is on your Entry Form & on your Motorsport Australia profile** on the portal.

12. AWARDS

Awards for races are only to consist of certificates supplied by the Victorian State Race Series Inc.

13. JUDGES OF FACT

At each round,

- (a) The Starter is appointed Judge of Fact with respect to:
 - (i) Compliance with the Starting Regulations.
- (b) The Chief Timekeeper is appointed Judge of Fact with regard to: -
 - (i) Whether each car is in the correct grid position immediately prior to the start of the race,
 - (ii) The order in which cars cross the finishing line at the end of each race, and the lap times achieved by each car during practice and races.
- (c) The Clerk of the Course, Assistant Clerks of the Course and the Chief Scrutineer are appointed Judges of Fact with regard to compliance with the regulations governing noise emissions.
