The Event will be a Victorian State Championship Race Meeting ,conducted at the Winton Motor Raceway in a clockwise direction on 15th and 16th of June 2019, held under the FIA International Sporting Code including Appendices, National Competition Rules of Confederation of Australian Motor Sport Ltd (CAMS), The Race Meeting Standing Regulations, the2019 CAMS Victorian State Circuit Racing Championship Series Regulations, the Winton Motor Raceway Standing Race Regulations, these Supplementary Regulations and any Further Regulations or instructions Issued for the Meeting.

Entries will open on publication of these Regulations and close on Monday 10th June 2019. Competitors are reminded of clause 83 of the NCR's of the CAMS Manual of Motors Sport regarding refusal of entries.

The Entry Fee will be \$415.00 (GST Inc) for entries received up to Monday 27th MAY, 2019 and \$445.00 (GST inc.) thereafter up until closing date.

A surcharge of \$120 including GST applies to any entry which nominates for more than one category with the same Driver. In these cases the Driver must indicate on the Entry Form his/hers first and second choice of which category they would like to run. A separate full Entry Fee is payable if the cross entry is for the same vehicle but with a different Driver. A separate full Entry Fee is also payable if a Driver enters more than one category with a different vehicle. Individual Entry Forms must be completed by each car and Driver.

All Drivers must be current financial members of CAMS affiliated clubs and hold a PCC,PC,CC, NC, ICC or other type of licence as approved for racing Events by CAMS.

Competition Numbers will be allocated at the Promoters discretion, where possible according to the categories allocated numbers which have been supplied to the series by the Category Representatives. Numbers will otherwise be allocated to best fit with category allocations and Competitors wishes as much as is possible. Only two figure number will be permitted.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Certain public, property, professional indemnity and personal accident insurance is provided by CAMS in relation to the Event. Further details can be found in the CAMS Insurance Handbook, available at www.cams.com.au.

Protests, if any, must be lodged in accordance with Part XII of the CAMS Manual.

The Promoter reserves the right to cancel, postpone or abandon the Event in accordance with NCR59.

Timing will be electronic and each Competitor will require a Dorian Transmitter, fitted in accordance with category provisions and in the left or right foot well of sedan based vehicles.

ALCOHOL, DRUGS AND OTHER SUBSTANCES

Any holder of a CAMS 'Competition' or 'Officials' licence (or equivalent licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of drugs (or other banned substances) and subject to a penalty for a breach in accordance with the CAMS Anti-Doping Policy and/or the CAMS Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy as published on the CAMS website. Consumption of alcohol in the paddock, pits or any section of the competition venue/course under the control of the Officials is forbidden until all competition is concluded each day. Accordingly, any holder of a CAMS 'Competition' or 'Officials' licence (or equivalent licence issued by another ASN) may also be tested for the presence of alcohol by a CAMS Accredited Testing Official (CATO) in accordance with the CAMS Standard Operating Procedure for Breath Alcohol Testing.

INVITED CATEGORIES

Formula Ford 1600 & Formula Ford, Improved Production Cars, Formula Vee, Sports Cars(Group 2Bi & 2Bii,2F & (including Invited 2A FIA GT3 & GT4 – as listed in Appendix A of the 2019 VSCRC Regulations, 5th category Sa, Sb, Sc, Group T), Porsche 944 Challenge, Saloon Cars, Circuit Excels, Sports Sedans.

FUEL REQUIREMENTS

Fuel must comply with Schedule G of the current CAMS Manual.

NOISE

Vehicles must be adequately muffled to comply with the 95 dB noise limit.

TARGETED SCRUTINY

Targeted Scrutiny procedures will apply. **PLEASE NOTE.** A photocopy or scan of the vehicle log book showing the last audit and the Events since is required to be submitted with your Entry Form. Vehicle Logbooks will be checked by Scrutineers to confirm which vehicles are due for audit; and if required, suitable arrangements will be made. Please note that this does not mean your car will not be subject to Scrutiny throughout the weekend. Drivers will be required to present upon request their current CAMS licence, CAMS affiliated car club membership, and vehicle logbook (if issued).

All Driver apparel shall comply with Schedule D of the 2019 CAMS Manual of Motor Sport and is also subject to Targeted Scrutiny.

it will render me in breach of NCR 144, and that I may be subject to penalties under the National Competition Rules. My signature below indicates my acceptance of the above declaration.

For Drivers

I, being the named Driver of the vehicle described on this form, hereby declare that I have been fully briefed by the Competitors on all aspects of the operation of the vehicle, including peculiarities relating to its handling and performance during competition; and I have satisfied myself that the vehicle is safe and suitable for the intended competition; and that my competition apparel, including helmet and any HANS® device is in compliance with Sch. D.

My signature below indicates my acceptance of the above declaration.

RISK WARNING, DISCLAIMER AND INDEMNITY

Motor Sport Activities are inherently dangerous recreational activities and there is significant risk of injury, disability or death.

If you do not wish to be exposed to such risks, then you should not participate in the Motor Sport Activities. I acknowledge that:

- the risks associated with attending or participating in Motor Sport Activities include but are NOT LIMITED to the risk that I may suffer harm as a result of:
 - motor vehicles (or parts of them) colliding with other motor vehicles or persons or property;
 - others participants acting dangerously or with lack of skills;
 - high levels of noise exposure;
 - acts of violence and other harmful acts (whether intentional or inadvertent) committed by persons attending or participating in the event; and
 - the failure or unsuitability of facilities (including grand-stands, fences and guard rails) to ensure my safety.

EXCLUSION OF LIABILITY, RELEASE & INDEMNITY

In exchange for being able to attend or participate in the Motor Sport Activities, I agree:

- to release CAMS and the Entities to the extent that any or all of them are providing Recreational Services from all liability for:
 - a) my death
 - b) any physical or mental injury (including the aggravation, acceleration or recurrence of such an injury);
 - c) the contraction, aggravation or acceleration of a **disease**;
 - d) the coming into existence, the aggravation, acceleration or recurrence of any other condition, circumstance, occurrence, activity, form of behavior, course of conduct or state of affairs:
 - i. that is or may be harmful or disadvantageous to me or the community; or
 - ii. that may result in harm or disadvantage to me or the community,

howsoever arising from my participation in or attendance at the Motor Sport Activities;

- to indemnify and hold harmless and keep indemnified the Entities to the maximum extent permitted by law in respect of any Claim by any person; and
- to attend at or participate in the Motor Sport Activities at my own risk. I understand

that:

- nothing in this document excludes, restricts or modifies any rights that I may have as a result of significant personal injury that is caused by the Reckless Conduct of the Entities as the supplier of the Motor Sport Activities / Recreational Services;
- nothing in this document prevents the Entities from relying on any laws (including statute and common law) that limit or preclude their liability;
- nothing in this document excludes any term or guarantee which under statute cannot be excluded; however the liability of the Entities is limited to the minimum liability allowable by law;
- nothing in this document precludes me from making a claim under a CAMS insurance policy where I am expressly entitled to make a claim under that insurance policy; and
- CAMS has arranged some limited personal injury insurance coverage which may provide me with some protection for loss, damage or injury that I may suffer during my participation in the Motor Sport Activities. However, I acknowledge and accept that the insurance taken out by CAMS may not provide me with full indemnity for loss, damage or injury that I may suffer during my participation in the Motor Sport Activities, and that I may have to pay the excess if a Claim is made under an insurance policy on my behalf. I agree that my own insurance arrangements are ultimately my responsibility and I will arrange any additional coverage at my expense after taking into account CAMS insurance arrangements, this document and my own circumstances.

WARNING APPLICABLE IN RELATION TO MOTOR SPORT ACTIVITIES HELD IN <u>VICTORIA</u> WARNING

UNDER THE AUSTRALIAN CONSUMER LAW AND FAIR TRADING ACT 2012:

Under the Australian Consumer Law (Victoria), several statutory guarantees apply to the supply of certain goods and services. These guarantees mean that the supplier named on this form is required to ensure that the recreational services it supplies to you:

- are rendered with due care and skill;
- are reasonably fit for any purpose which you either expressly or by implication, make known to the supplier; and
- might reasonably be expected to achieve any result you have made known to the supplier.

Under section 22 of the Australian Consumer Law and Fair Trading Act 2012 (Vic), the supplier is entitled to ask you to agree

that these conditions do not apply to you. If you sign this form, you will be agreeing that your rights to sue the supplier under the Australian Consumer Law and Fair Trading Act 2012 if you are killed or injured because the services were not in accordance with these guarantees, are excluded, restricted or
